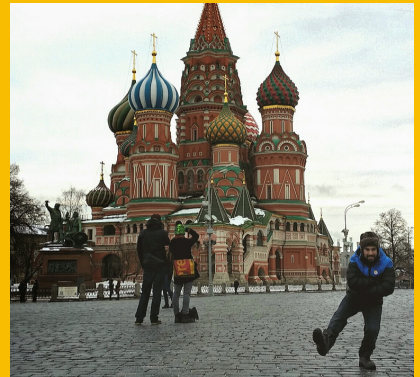

# PROJECTS DESCRIPTION

These are long-term EVS projects that take place in Saint Petersburg, Russia. The main objectives are social work and social integration - support of people with physical and mental disabilities.

**DURATION:** 12 months

## **VOLUNTEERING WITH CHILDREN WITH PHYSICAL AND MENTAL DISABILITIES IN ORPHANAGE IN PAVLOVSK (1.5 HOURS FROM THE CITY CENTRE)**

Volunteering in state run orphanage with mentally and physically disabled children (aged 5 to 18). We support and provide individual assistance to the children living in the orphanage. Daily duties of volunteer include: organising playing activities, hygienic care, feeding, accompanying children in various trips, assistance in school classes, organising events.

## **VOLUNTEERING WITH CHILDREN WITH PHYSICAL AND MENTAL DISABILITIES IN DAY CARE CENTRE IN ST PETERSBURG**

We help children with physical and mental disabilities from families of St Petersburg. They attend our day care centre for children on daily basis. Volunteer communicates with children, assists them at classes, plays with them, accompanies them in trips and excursions and helps with feeding and hygiene.

## **VOLUNTEERING WITH CHILDREN WITH PHYSICAL AND MENTAL DISABILITIES AT SCHOOL #25 IN ST PETERSBURG**

Volunteering in school with mentally and physically disabled children (aged 7 to 17).

Daily duties of volunteer include: personal assistance in the classroom, hygienic care and assistance at dinner, accompanying children in various trips.

# PROJECTS DESCRIPTION

## **VOLUNTEERING WITH ADULTS WITH PHYSICAL AND MENTAL DISABILITIES IN BOARDING HOUSE IN PETERHOF (1,5 HOURS FROM THE CITY CENTRE)**

Volunteering in state run boarding house with mentally and physically disabled adult people (aged 18-60). We support and provide individual assistance to the adult people living in the boarding house.

Daily duties of volunteer include: hygienic care, assistance in the workshops (ceramics, computer class, handcraft, music and art workshops), feeding, accompanying wards in various trips.

## **VOLUNTEERING WITH YOUNG PEOPLE WITH PHYSICAL AND MENTAL DISABILITIES IN DAY CARE CENTRE IN ST PETERSBURG**

We help young people (aged 18-35) with physical and mental disabilities from families of St Petersburg. They attend our day care centre for adult people on daily basis. Volunteer communicates with young people, assists them at workshops (housekeeping, plant growing, soap-making classes, objets d'art making, classes on diverse cultures), helps with feeding and hygiene and accompanies them in trips and excursions.

## **VOLUNTEERING WITH ADULTS WITH PHYSICAL AND MENTAL DISABILITIES IN THE PROJECT OF SUPPORTED LIVING IN RAZDOLYE (2 HOURS FROM ST PETERSBURG)**

The project of supported living is a village house where people with disabilities live with support and assistance of specialists and volunteers.

Volunteer communicates with residents, assists them at workshops, accompanies them in trips and excursions, helps with feeding and hygiene and brings new ideas to the work.

**have basic level of Russian or highly motivated to learn it**
